## **FOR YOUR INFORMATION**

Section 4 (11) of the Casual Trading Act, 1995, provides that the local authority concerned shall notify the Minister for Social Welfare of the name and the address of a person to whom a casual trading licence was granted and the conditions of the licence.

- (2) Section 4(2A) of the Casual Trading act, 1995 (inserted by section 141 of the Finance Act, 1996 (No. 9 of 1996) provides that the local authority concerned shall shall notify the Revenue Commissioners of the name, address and tax reference number of a person to whom a casual trading licence was granted and the conditions of the licence.

Section 13 of the Casual Trading Act, 1995, also provides that a local authority may establish and maintain the Register of Casual Trading Licences on computer. In such circumstances, personal data kept in the register is subject to the requirements of the Data Protection Act, 1988 (No. 25 of 1988) including an individual's right of access to and verification of data, where appropriate.

It will be a condition of any licence granted that adequate Public Liability Insurance cover is in place. (Limit of Indemnity of €2,539,476.15).
