

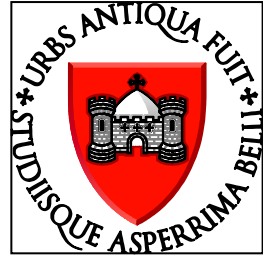

1. All applications for 'off-site' waste disposal to the Bunlicky WwTP should be made by post to Water Services Department, Limerick City Council, City Hall, Limerick.
2. €120 application fee is applicable to new licences. Cheques to be made payable to 'Limerick City Council'.
3. Please note the terms and conditions detailed on page 3 applicable to this licence
4. This licence will be reviewed on annual basis.
5. Please be advised that all imports are to be weighed at the weighbridge and there will be a charge levied annually by Limerick City Council against materials delivered to the treatment plant refer to condition No. 8 on page 3.
6. On approval of your submission, Severn Trent Response Ltd (STR) will issue you a fob for entry for disposal to the Bunlicky Wastewater Treatment Plant.
7. STR reserve the right to refuse entry to the treatment plant and to veto disposal of waste that are not in compliance with the licence issued.

Please note the following terms and conditions are applicable on issue of the licence:

Terms and Conditions:

1. Copies of your waste permit, insurances (public indemnity, public liability & motor) and safety statement should be lodged with STR Ltd at the Bunlicky WwTP site office prior to the commencement of deliveries. Please note your safety statement/ code of practice should highlight to employees the risks associated with sewage and the control measures in place to provide protection from sewage borne diseases.
2. All Drivers entering the site must:
 - safe pass card or equivalent approved
 - have received manual handling training
 - receive induction training to the site prior to the disposal of waste
 - sign in and out when delivering the waste. Failure to sign in and sign out will incur a penalty and a suspension to dispose of waste
 - wear Hi-Vis clothing whilst on site
 - notify a staff member on site of their arrival
3. For non-domestic imports - copies of an independent laboratory analysis of the waste must be lodged with STR Ltd at the Bunlicky WwTP site office prior to the commencement of deliveries. Copies of analysis of the parameters COD, BOD, TP, TN, Ammonia and ph on the waste to be disposed are required. Please note that random testing will be carried out at the WwTP to ensure the waste is in compliance with this licence.
4. All vehicles on site are to be fit for purpose; i.e. roadworthy (DOE), reversing beepers, tanker clear certificate i.e. not contaminated.
5. The liquid waste must be discharged by gravity from your tanker into an underground pump station i.e. not to be blown out to clear debris in the tanker. It is an requirement to have onboard your transporter a suitable length (approx. 5 meters) of flexible hose and couplers to facilitate this method of unloading.
6. Deliveries to the plant must be made between the hours of 09:00 to 16:00 hours from Monday to Friday inclusive. Please note hours of operation for liquid/cake sludge into the sludge reception hall is to be disposed of between the hours of 08.30 to 13:00 hours from Monday to Friday inclusive
7. A computer record will be maintained for all deliveries to site. The importer is expected to produce a docket stating the source of the waste, date and the amount of waste delivered, and to have this docket signed by SRT Ltd staff on site.
8. All imports are to be weighed at the weighbridge. Invoicing will be carried out annually by Limerick City Council for the cost of processing the liquid waste delivered. The cost per cubic metre (225 gallons) is €3.50 (subject to change). The cost of processing the liquid and cake sludges delivered to the site is €6.50 (subject to change) per cubic metre (225 gallons).
9. Any costs involved to recover loss of production due to disposing of waste outside of the conditions of this licence including and not limited to cleaning, pump replacement, hire of crane etc will be invoiced to the importer.
