The 6 houses were finished by 1838 but the subscription Book stayed open until 1840. Thus the ages of the nominees cannot be subtracted from 1840 to arrive at the date of birth of each nominee. See John Massy as example.

Col. William Strange Butson, son of James Strange Butson, died on the 10 March 1911. William had a 2 years younger sister called Susanna. There is no sister Letitia recorded. The Letitia named over, died in 1888. Maybe Susanna Letitia was her full name.

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No date found for marriage. James was born in Scotland in 1789. Died in Limerick 15/8/1853. Jane died 20/6/1872. Both buried, St Munchins. George was a Barrister and lived in Dublin. He married Louisa Coffey on 19/8/1863. James Cree had a Corn Store in Cornmarket Row but lived at Brown's Quay, Thomond Gate. George entered TCD, 1/7/1846 aged 17. Son of James Cree, Merchant, of Limerick. George died on the 24/11/1910. James lived on Distillery Rd. Thomond Gate in 1852.

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Their Marriage Settlement was dated 9/2/1838. William Croker Deacon must have been their  $I^{st}$  son and Heir. Unfortunately he died young in June 1847. George died on the 22/11/1886. This family were based in England.

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No record found of their marriage. They may have married in England.
Catherine wed Sir Thomas Moore. She was also still living in 1913 and was one of the six nominees who survived to make the holder of her share the owner of one of the six houses in Pery Square.

The Tontine Records note that he died in America some time prior to 1901.

Edward wed Elizabeth, 25/3/1816 Susan Mary Hartigan married John Crighton Stuart McDonnall as his 2<sup>nd</sup> wife, in 1864

on a visit to Australia. He died in 1891. Susan died on the 5/9/1906.

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Edward and Ellen were both from Co. Cork They married on the 14/10/1807 and moved to Limerick in 1814. Edward Snr. died in 1839 Edward Jnr. died 28/10/1843. Ellen continued the Pawnbroking business after her husband's death.

No record of wedding found for parents Michael became Dean of Limerick. Sarah wed Frederick Hammersley and lived in England. Her husband died in 1901 a Major-General. Her son, also Frederick also became a Major General and shared in the blame for the failed attack at Suvla Bay in 1915. Sarah was still alive on the 23 April 1913 and was one of the last six survivors of the Tontine.

The whole idea was to pick a young person who would outlive the others. Whichever six youngsters lived the longest would each win a valuable house in Pery Square for whoever owned or held the winning subscriptions when the list of nominees had been reduced to six survivors.
