NOTICE TO SHEEP OWNERS

DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNICAL INSTRUCTION FOR IRELAND

SHEEP DIPPING (IRELAND) ORDER OF 1915

[THE Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland desire to draw attention to the obligation which, in pursuance of the above Order, now made by the Department, is imposed on the owner of sheep in Ireland, to cause all such sheep, excepting those exempted under the Order, to be dipped during the period between the 1st day of June and the 1st day of July, both days inclusive (the "summer dipping period"); and on two occasions separated by an interval of not less than seven days or more than fourteen days, between the 1st day of August and the 1st day of November, both days inclusive (the "autumn dipping period").]

[The following is a summary of some of the other provisions in the Order which should be strictly observed.]

Notice of Intention to Dip.—For the purpose of enabling the Local Authority, if they so wish, to be present at the dipping, the owner of sheep, or the person in charge of the dipping, must give notice of the intention to dip, stating the date (or dates) in the case of the autumn dipping, and the place (or places) in the case of the autumn dipping, of the dipping, and the date (or dates) in the case of the summer dipping, to the Local Authority, at least seven days before the dipping is to take place.

Number of Sheep to be Dipped.—The number of sheep which are to be dipped, and the place where such sheep are to be dipped, must be stated in the notice given to the Local Authority.

Time of Dipping.—The dipping must be completed by the owner or person in charge of the dipping, on or before the date specified in the notice given to the Local Authority.

Isolation of Sheep After Dipping.—All sheep which have been dipped must be kept in a separate enclosure, and must not be mixed with sheep which have not been dipped.

Cleaning of Dipping Flats.—The place used for dipping must be kept clean, and must be disinfected after each dipping.

Examples of Dip may be Taken.—When sheep are being dipped under the Order, the owner or person in charge of the dipping must be prepared to furnish a sample of the dipping material, which is being or has been used for the dipping.

Declaration by Owner of Farm or Holding.—The owner of a farm or holding on which sheep are kept must, at the time of the dipping, make a declaration to the Local Authority, stating that the sheep are being dipped in accordance with the provisions of the Order.

Penalties.—If the owner of a farm or holding on which sheep are kept fails to comply with the provisions of the Order, he may be liable to a fine of not more than £100.

Enforcement of Order.—The Local Authority may, if they so wish, cause the sheep to be dipped, and may, if they so wish, cause the dipping material to be supplied.

Application for Exemption.—If the owner of a farm or holding on which sheep are kept wishes to apply for an exemption from the provisions of the Order, he must apply to the Local Authority.

Ireland's Trade

FIGURES are invariably dry and uninteresting

but they are none the less necessary and useful.

Those relating to the trade in imports and

exports at Irish ports during the year 1914 are

worthy of some personal and examination just

now. They are contained in a rather bulky

report issued a few days ago by the Depart-

ment of Agriculture and Technical Instruction.

The publication of the volume, it is pointed

out, has been unavoidably delayed by the fact

that most of the clerical staff engaged in its

compilation have joined the army or navy since

the outbreak of the war. In the tables and

statistics submitted Irish imports and exports

made all goods imported or exported by

Ireland, whether from or to Great Britain,

the Colonies, or foreign countries. The

total of such trade for the twelve months

ended on the 31st December, 1914, is estimated

at £210,970,320 as compared with £147,500,838

in 1913, an increase of not far short of three

and a half millions. The exports showed an

increase of nearly three and a half millions

also, while the imports were less than those for

the previous year by £13,981. A statement

covering eleven years shows that since 1904

there has been a steady increase in both im-

ports and exports each year, with one or two

exceptions. The trade in 1914, it is shown,

was an improvement on that for 1913, and

exceeded the records of any of the preceding

ten or eleven years. In considering,

however, the increase or decrease

in trade it should be borne in mind,

as the report points out, that the rise and fall

in the total value is to a considerable extent

due to the rise or fall in the prices of com-
modities. In recent years the fall in prices
of many commodities has been a marked upward
tendency in prices. It is well to remember in this
connection that the average prices for 1914
were not considerably in excess of those for
1913. The high war prices from August of
1914 to the end of the year were only just able
to counterbalance the sharp fall in prices from
the beginning of the year to the outbreak of
the war. "The total value of the import and
export trade of Ireland," says the report, "has
increased in a most satisfactory manner since
1904, but the increase in the volume of the
trade has not been so great. This latter in-
crease may be measured by assuming that
prices have remained the same in each suc-
ceeding year as in 1904." A table is given showing
that while the total value of imports in 1914
had only very slightly increased, the volume
had appreciably decreased. The total value
and volume of exports had considerably in-
creased.
