permission, or whether on payment or otherwise,

(v) any foreshore or coastal waters within or adjoining the County Borough of Limerick.

5.(1) Any person having charge of any dog shall at all times while exercising the dog in any public place carry suitable receptacles to remove and dispose of dog droppings immediately after the dog has deposited them. This receptacle must be available for inspection by an authorised officer on request. Plastic bags, paper bags or acceptable pooper scoopers are examples of proper receptacles.

5.(2) Where a public litter bin or similar receptacle is used to dispose of the droppings, they must be suitably wrapped or contained to prevent fouling the receptacle.

6.(1) Any person exercising or in charge of a dog or dogs in a patrolled public park shall keep the dog(s) on a leash and under proper control at all times.


7.(1) Authorised persons are members of the Garda Síochána, Environmental Inspectors, Park Rangers and any other duly authorised persons.


7.(2) A person guilty of an offence under this byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine. The fine for any of the above offences is €150.

8.(1) If an Environmental Inspector, member of the Garda Síochána, Park Ranger or authorised person has reasonable grounds for believing that a person is committing or has committed a prescribed offence under this Bye-law they may give the person a notice in prescribed form stating the following :
